II. Plumbing Restrictions. The following unacceptable		ing Restrictions. The following unacceptable plumbing practices are prohibited by State regulations.	
	A.	No direct connection between the public drinking water supply and a potential source of contamination is permitted. Potential sources of contamination shall be isolated from the public water system by an air-gap or a reduced pressure-zone backflow prevention device.	
	В.	No cross-connection between the public drinking water supply and a private water system is permitted. These potential sources of contamination shall be isolated from the public water system by an air-gap or an appropriate backflow prevention device.	
	C.	No connection which allows water to be returned to the public water supply is permitted.	
	D.	No pipe fitting which contains more than 8.0% lead may be used for the installation or repair of plumbing at any connection which provides water for human use.	
	E.	No solder or flux which contains more than 0.2% lead can be used for the installation or repair of plumbing at any connection which provides water for human use.

These inspections shall be conducted by the District or its designated agent prior to initiating new water service; when there is reason to believe that cross-connections or other unacceptable plumbing practices exist; or after any major changes to private plumbing facilities. The inspection shall be conducted during the District's normal business hours.	
	C.	The District shall notify the Customer in writing of any cross-connection or other unacceptable plumbing practice which has been identified during the initial inspection or periodic re-inspection.	
	D.	The Customer shall immediately correct any unacceptable plumbing practices on his premises.	
	E.	The Customer shall, at his expense, properly install, test, and maintain any backflow prevention device required by the District. Copies of all testing and maintenance records shall be provided to the District.
